Dear Alan:

Recently, we talked casually about how the product Militec-1 has helped me in the dental office. I thought I would write to confirm these miracles!

In September of '92, my high speed drill gave out. The turbine was shot. I oiled it with light machine oil as a prelude to throwing it out. It lasted another week and then no amount of oil would get it to turn. I replaced it with a used but workable spare and ordered a new handpiece and a new turbine for the old drill (\$305). Before the new equipment arrived, the old standby ground to a halt. I was in a real pickle.

In a flash of clairvoyance, I remembered the stuff you sold to me 1 1/2 years earlier. I vividly remembered the startling demonstration you gave with the small motor and the different oils, and then showed how, with the use of Militec-1, no amount of available force could cause enough friction to stop the motor.

I applied the Militec-1, albeit diluted with my oil because of the more convenient delivery system to the originally broken handpiece. That was in October, '92. Alan, I have not applied any more than the one application. I had a very busy December for which I used the drill extensively. The drill works at all speeds, not just with maximum air force.
